

The argumentum resurrectionis 1 Cor 15:12-20

Abstract: As well as knowing the valid inference and logical truth of the argumentum resurrectionis 1 Cor 15:12-20, we deal with proofs of propositional calculus. Now it could firstly be proved by means of quantificational schemes that the argument turns out invariant as to the question of general or particular resurrection, i.e. „there be resurrection of all dead“ and „... of at least one dead“ are both inferential conclusions. The argument is without any empirical content since its truth does not depend on any empirical data.
