Abstract: The argumentum resurrectionis 1 Cor 15:12-20 consists of empirical propositions without any possibility to point out their truth values. Nevertheless, there are confusions as to the relations between logical inference and truth or falsity of premises and conclusions. In regard of 1 Cor 15:13 the enthymematic enlargement suggested by Bachmann yields inconsistency with the supposition of particular and consistency with the supposition of general resurrection.
